

10th Remembrance Days

27 January – at 12.00 a.m. – solemn laying of flowers at the Radegast station (Avenue of Remembrance for the Victims of the Litzmannstadt Ghetto 12), 6:00 p.m. –The last stage. 75th anniversary of the liberation of the Auschwitz-Birkenau camp, historical introduction by Adam Sitarek and projection of the film „The Last Stage”, dir. by W. Jakubowska, 1947, the Marek Edelman Dialogue Center in Lodz.

29 January – at 06:00 p.m. – solemn opening of the 10th Remembrance Days and an inaugural „Yiddish Tango” concert by Olga Avigail & Tango Attack, the Big Stage of the Stefan Jaracz Theatre in Lodz.

30 January, at 5:00 p.m. – „Holocaust Remembrance – a Look in Poland, the World, and in Israel” – a discussion panel with the participation of invited guests and a special screening of the animated film” Egzekucja Pamięci” [”The Execution of Remembrance”], the Marek Edelman Dialogue Centre.

1 February, at 6:00 p.m. – spectacle ”Egzamin z zagłady” [”Holocaust Examination”] – a

monodrama by Małgorzata Bańka, the Small Stage of the Stefan Jaracz Theatre in Lodz.

2 February, at 12:00 a.m. "Magiczny Medalion" ["The Magic Medallion"] – an interactive spectacle for children, Chamber Stage of the Stefan Jaracz Theatre in Lodz, at 4.00 p.m. – screening of the film "Falenicka Atlantyda" [„Falenica Atlantis"] and meeting with the director, the Marek Edelman Dialogue Centre in Lodz.

3 February, at 11.30 a.m. – workshops for schools run by the Warsaw Ghetto Museum at the Stefan Jaracz Theatre in Lodz, at 1.00 p.m. – workshops for schools run by the Warsaw Ghetto Museum at the Bałuty Community Centre, at 6:00 p.m. – final gala of the 10th Remembrance Days – concert of the KROKE band, the Big Stage of the Stefan Jaracz Theatre in Lodz.
