The English-language tours will take place every day from April 19 to April 22, 2023. Choose between the 'Small' or 'Large' Ghetto Walks or participate in both.

The "Small" Ghetto Tour
Every day at 10 am and 2 pm

60 Sienna St., gate of the former Bersohn and Bauman Hospital

The "Large" Ghetto Tour
Every day at 12 am and 4 pm

near the 'Anielewicz Bunker' Memorial, Dubois St. – intersection with Miła St.

The Warsaw Ghetto was a heartbreaking reality for the Jewish population of Warsaw during World War II. Isolated in November of 1940, the Warsaw Ghetto was the largest of all the Jewish ghettos set up by Nazi Germany across Europe. Despite its size, the Warsaw Ghetto was incredibly overcrowded, with over 400,000 Jews crammed into an area of only 3 square kilometers. As a result, the Ghetto became known as a city within a city.

During the tours, we will explore the history of the Warsaw Ghetto and its inhabitants' struggle

for survival.

The “Small” Ghetto Tour

Starts every above day at 10 am and 2 pm

Meeting point > at the entrance to Bersohn and Bauman Hospital building – future seat of the Warsaw Ghetto Museum, Warsaw, 60 Sienna Street

Duration – 2 hours

We will explore the southern part of the former ghetto area.

The “Large” Ghetto tour

Starts every above day at 12:00 pm and 4:00 pm

Meeting point> at the archaeological excavation site near the ‘Anielewicz Bunker’ Memorial on the side of Dubois Street near the intersection with Miła Street

Duration – 2 hours

We will explore the northern part of the former ghetto area.

No prior registration needed – just arrive at the meeting spot!
